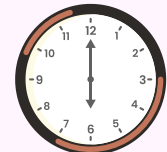

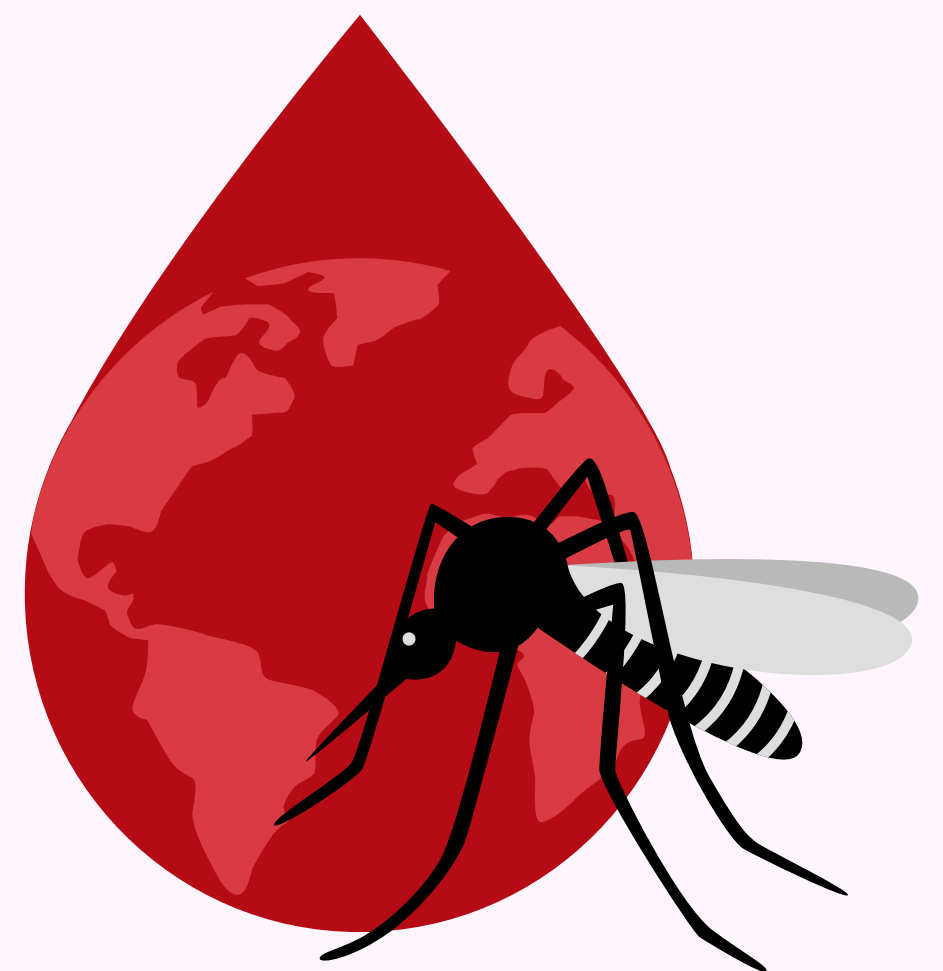

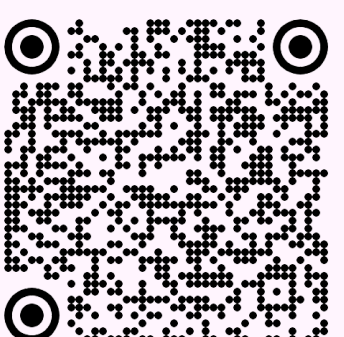
2 Building Trust and Community Engagement:

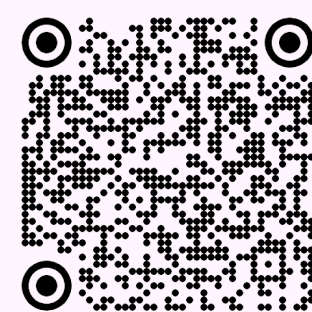
