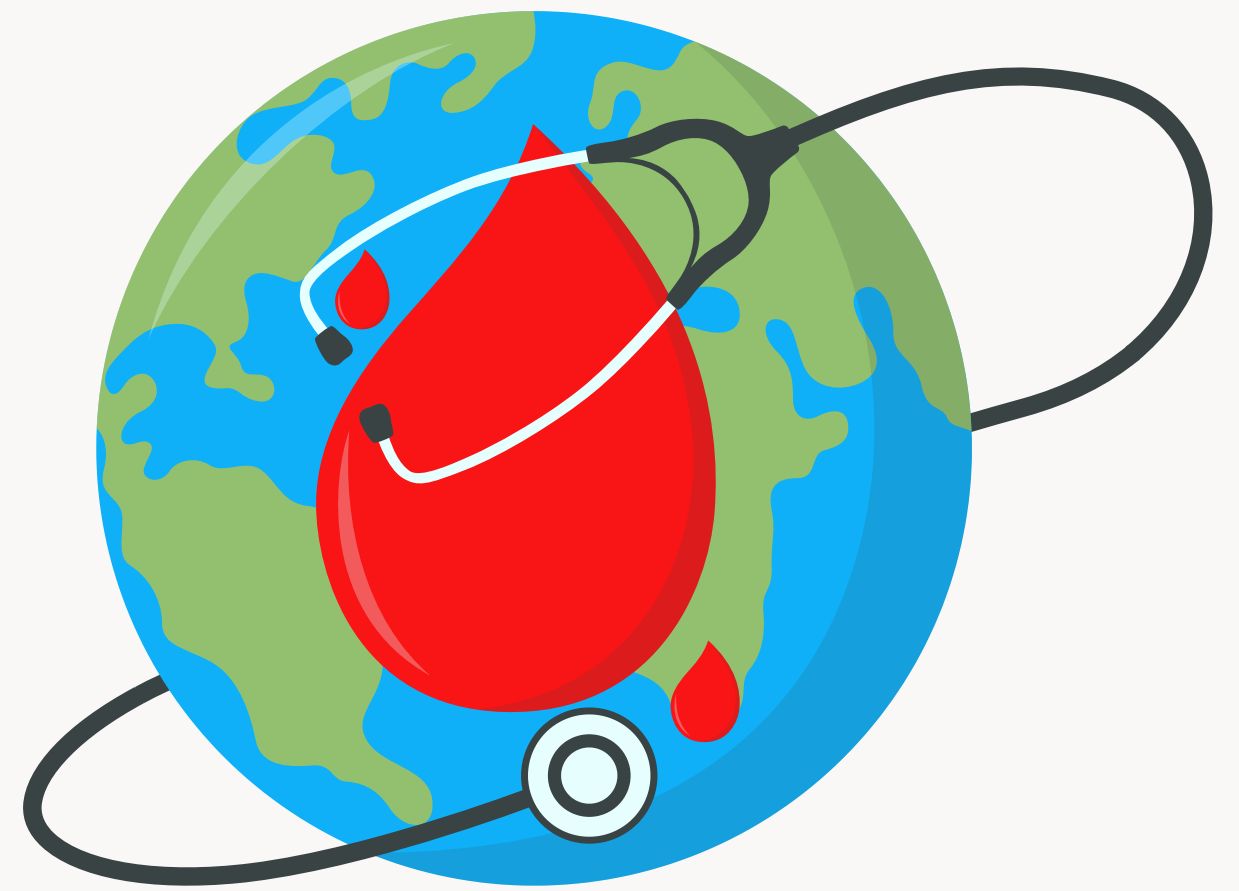

THEME: HIDDEN NO MORE: FINDING THE UNDIAGNOSED. SUPPORTING THE UNSEEN

FOCUS: This campaign emphasizes the urgent need to identify undiagnosed individuals, strengthen early screening and timely care, and ensure visibility, support, and equitable access for every person living with thalassaemia.

Highlights:



1 Early Detection & Universal Screening:

Strengthen nationwide screening programs to identify carriers and undiagnosed cases at an early stage. Promote premarital and antenatal screening to reduce disease burden and enable informed family planning.



2 Equitable Access to Quality Care:

Strengthen healthcare infrastructure and trained workforce to manage thalassaemia effectively. Promote affordable and accessible treatment options for all patients, regardless of geography or socio-economic status.



3 Awareness, Advocacy & Patient Support:

Increase public awareness to reduce stigma and improve understanding of thalassaemia. Empower patients and families through education, psychosocial support, and community networks.
